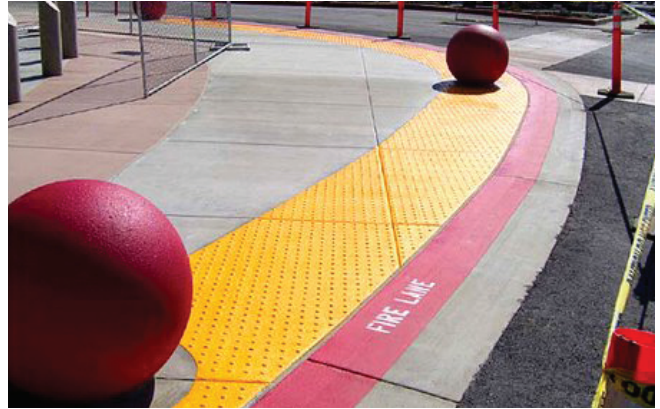


Truncated Domes – Quality installation by Trueline

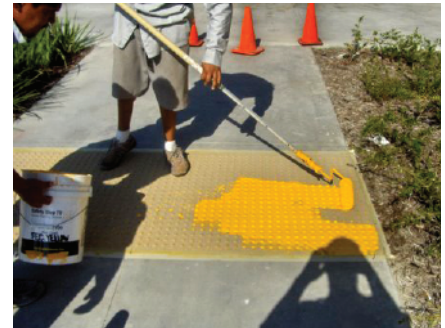
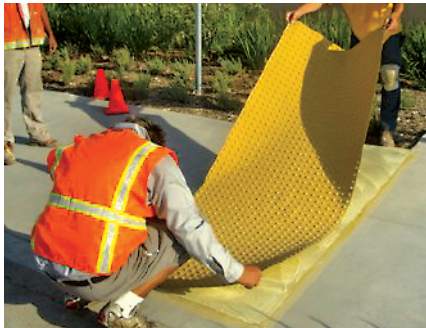
Truncated Domes, or tactile warning tiles are required by state and federal law to assist the visually impaired. To help businesses comply with these requirements, **Trueline Striping** has become expert in the installation of truncated dome mats for any particular application.

While there are many manufactures of truncated dome solutions, Trueline uses strictly the product developed by Safety Step TD. The genius behind the Safety Step concept is the use of a thin fiberlath base. The thin mats, unlike other bulky thick tiles on the market, easily bond to existing concrete, conform easily to any surface and resist wear and tear, staying in place while other tiles over time loosen and rise, becoming a hazard instead of a help to the visually impaired individuals who count on them.



Truncated domes warn the sight-impaired they are leaving a pedestrian walkway and entering an area of traffic.

Trueline's Installation Process (7 steps)



- Step 1 Shot blast or Sandblast areas affected. and install border tape on all sides of work area
- Step 2 Apply thin prime coat on surface.
- Step 3 Install adhesive base coat and install fitted mat in wet base coat.

- Step 4 Apply second base coat evenly over the entire mat.
- Step 5 Broadcast sand onto wet adhesive evenly.
- Step 6 Apply color coat evenly.
- Step 7 Apply clear protective coat.

Advantages of Trueline-Installed Systems:

With this system the mats are literally glued down to the surface. The mats fuse with concrete or asphalt, and can be repainted. The mats are slip resistant, as well as repairable when needed.

Our mats have such a low profile that they have almost no lip at all. Our system meets all federal and state ADA requirements.

Another great benefit of this system is its ability to be molded and placed around structures and manholes or monuments. All while maintaining the legal dome spacing required by the ADA.
